Have you ever been in a City Council meeting and wondered how you could get a copy of the whole packet the City Council has? All of these questions can be answered by going to the new City web site.

The city staff has spent many hours this past year designing our new web site and putting the most commonly requested information on the site. We have also included common items such as codes, requirements, and forms that can be accessed by using your computer or mobile device.

There is a great feature that allows you to sign up for notifications for when agendas, public hearings, job openings, newsletters, and emergency alerts are posted. You can also sign up for an email alert or text message alert to be notified when it is the proper week for you to take your recycle can to the curb for pickup.

There is a very nice calendar feature on the main page which will allow you to look at what is happening in the city. For instance, if you click on the month of August and then click on the Old West Days event you will find out what week the Old West Days is happening and from there you can click on a link that will take you directly to the Old West Days web site where you can see detailed information.







water! Who doesn't love an ice-cold soda on a scorching summer day? It's nice to gulp down something refreshing, but I challenge you to trade your carbonation for some H₂O. Water helps keep your electrolytes balanced, which in turn increases your energy. Staying hydrated also prevents headaches, increases focus, and helps your body stay cool- especially in the summer heat. Thinking long-term, drinking plenty of water will keep your tissues in good shape, maintain kidney function, and decrease fat. 8 glasses of water a day is the rule of thumb, but there is another formula. City Hall Construction Update

Construction on the new City Hall continues.



The building will be heated and cooled with a geothermal system. Liquid will be pumped into hoses that go 300 feet into the ground to be heated or cooled by the earth's natural core temperature.

The utility connections have been installed. The steel for construction will be delivered this month.

Bangerter Highway Construction Update


At the beginning of August, UDOT will begin a maintenance project on Bangerter Highway from I-15 to 9000 S. The goal of this project is to extend the life of the existing concrete pavement. By completing this project UDOT is able to preserve Bangerter Highway by applying cost effective treatments before major repairs are required. Construction will be mainly night work and is expected to last about four months.
