Mayor Pro Tempore Wendy Aston called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

ADMINISTRATION OF THE OATH OF OFFICE FOR NEWLY ELECTED OFFICIALS

1. Roll Call.

Mayor Pro Tem Aston thanked those present for their attendance. She asked Mayor Elect Natalie Hall to sit with the City Council. 3. Adjournment.


