REGULAR BUSINESS MEETING

1. Welcome and Roll Call.

Chair Jenny Bass called the meeting to order at 5:37 p.m. and welcomed those present.

2. Approval of the April 7, 2022, Meeting Minutes.

Andrea Hales moved to APPROVE the minutes of the April 7, 2022, meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission. Rhonda Pilcher seconded the motion. Vote on motion: Andrea Hales-Aye; Rhonda Pilcher-Aye; Jenny Bass-Aye. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Other Business (Reports, Updates, Upcoming Items, Follow-Up, Etc.)

Prior to the motion to approve the April 7, 2022, meeting minutes, the Historic Preservation Commission reviewed the minutes and decisions of the April 7, 2022, meeting. There was discussion regarding when the next meeting would be. Since July 7 is the first Thursday of the next odd-numbered month, the decision was made to hold the next meeting then, subject to change. The Utah Open Public Meetings Training was tentatively scheduled to occur at the July meeting. City Recorder, Wendy Deppe, would inquire with the City Attorney as to availability. It was noted that City Attorney, Todd Sheeran, announced his imminent departure as Bluffdale City Attorney.

It was reported that there was no current plan for grant applications.

The Historic Preservation Commission (“HPC”) planned to have a booth at the Love where you Live event. There was also follow-up discussion on having a booth at Old West Days on August 8 through 13.

There was discussion regarding Lorraine Day, who has some land history papers that are very fragile and historically significant. Chair Bass expressed her desire to have Ms. Day attend the next HPC meeting. Commissioner Pilcher, whose mother is a good friend of Lorraine Day, said she would visit with her mother to facilitate Ms. Day’s visit at the next meeting.

The HPC would be providing information about the Bringhurst Station at the Love where you Live event that was scheduled for May 23 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Discussion took place regarding when the Commissioners should arrive to help set up and what to bring.

It was reported that work still needed to be done to download interviews from phones to a computer.

Commissioner Jones reported that he and his wife attended a conference in April. He would discuss it at a future meeting. He had information about the Bringham Station that would also be helpful. Senior City Planner, Jennifer Robison, was identified as a resource for information regarding the historic site. Chair Bass stated that she would phone Mrs. Robison about it.

Chair Bass reported that she needs to contact Associate City Planner, Ellen Oakman, about a contact she has. The gentleman is named Lynn Kimball and he has family records of individuals who have owned property in Bluffdale.

There was discussion regarding what needs to be done for the next Old Town Days booth. Last year's booth was excellent so replication should be easy to achieve this year. There was a large picture of Porter Rockwell that needs to be located and used again. There was additional discussion on artifacts that could be gathered for use at the booth. The booth was considered an excellent way to help residents learn about the history and heritage of their community.

It was suggested that a determination should be made as to whether there are aerial views of the area over the years to see how it has changed.

The next Historic Preservation Commission Meeting was scheduled for July 7, 2022, at 5:30 p.m.

The Commissioners thanked Wendy Deppe for filling in for Ms. Oakman at tonight's meeting.

The passing of many elderly people has resulted in lost opportunities to add to the historical legacy of Bluffdale. This sad reality emphasizes the urgency of conducting and recording interviews of long-term residents. A group of siblings was identified as an excellent group to interview.
