



YOU'RE INVITED! ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY PUBLIC MEETING OPPORTUNITIES

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) has recently started a State Environmental Study (SES) to evaluate a potential freeway-style interchange at Bangerter Highway and 2700 West in order to reduce congestion and improve safety. The study is scheduled for completion in early 2022, with construction slated for 2023*.

The study team is hosting two initial public meetings to gather feedback about overall transportation needs and environmental issues that should be considered during the study.
